

Cell Phone Case

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Finished size: 3"x4"

Materials:

- 1 roll size 9 Omega La Espiga nylon thread, #62 variegated purple
- metal clasp
- Size D aluminum crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Button
- Velcro
- Fray Check - Dabbing fray check on the ends is necessary when using nylon thread which ravel easily. When coming to an end or changing colors work over the thread just like yarn but leave a little more thread. Then clip close to the stitches and immediately dab Fray Check on the end and the surrounding area on the inside of your work. It can darken the thread so dab lightly but make sure it's saturated.

Round 1 - Ch 15. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 13 ch. 14 sc. Ch 1, turn.

Round 2 - Sc in 1st and 2nd sc, (ch 1, skip next sc, sc in next sc) 6 times. Ch 1, turn.

Round 3 - Sc in 1st sc, (sc in next ch 1 space, ch 1, skip next sc) 6 times. Sc in last sc. Ch 1, turn.

Rounds 4-57 - Repeat round 3. Ending on **right side**. Do no fasten off.

Edging - Sc in same stitch as last sc on round 57. Continue down long side of rectangle with 2 sc's at the end of every other row. 2 sc's in corner, 1 sc in ea stitch on opposite short side, 2 sc's in corner. Finish other long side same as first, 2 sc's in last corner. Sc in 1st sc on last unworked edge. Skip next ch 1 sp, sc in next sc, skip ch 1, sc, ch 1 and sc. 5 dc in next ch 1 space, skip sc, ch 1, sc, and ch 1. Sc in last 2 sc's. Sl st in beginning sc of edging. Fasten off.

Fold over rectangle at the 22nd row with leftover flap containing the 5 dc's, wrong sides facing each other. Attach thread to bottom corner and matching stitch for stitch on folded over section, ch 1. Work (sl st, ch 1) in ea stitch

around all 3 sides. Fasten off. Attach button to front near base of 5 dc's.
Attach small piece of Velcro underneath button for closure.

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
