

Loopy Necklace

Finished size: 20"

Materials:

1 roll #5 Omega nylon, color #36 variegated pink used

#4 steel crochet hook

2 small jewelry rings

1 lobster clasp

Fray Check - Dabbing fray check on the ends is necessary when using nylon thread which ravels easily. When coming to an end or changing colors work over the thread just like yarn but leave a little more thread. Then clip close to the stitches and immediately dab Fray Check on the end and the surrounding area on the inside of your work. It can darken the thread so dab lightly but make sure it's saturated.

Ch 166 (Base chain)

Row 1 - Sc in 2nd and 3rd chs from hook, skip 8 ch. (Ch 12, sc in 7th ch from hook, ch 5, sc in base ch, skip 8 ch) repeat 18 times, ending with sc in last 2 ch. Ch 1.

Row 2 - Turn work clockwise to work down other side of base ch. (Sl st in next ch, ch 1) repeat across, ending with sl st in last ch. Ch 1.

Row 3 - Turn work clockwise to work down other side. Sl st in 2 sc, sl st in next 5 ch, sc in ch 4 loop. [(Ch 2, 2 dc in ch 4 loop, ch 2, sc in ch 4 loop) 3 times. Sl st in 5 ch, sl st in sc, sl st in 5 ch, sc in ch 4 loop], repeat across, ending with sl st in last 2 sc. Fasten off.

Open rings and slip through stitches on each end, inserting lobster clasp in ring on one side. Close rings.
